Annual Meeting [& BBQ]

The GCC Bylaws specify the annual meeting fall on the 2nd Saturday in June. We will post the Rt 104 sign the week prior as a reminder.

The Annual Meeting, in addition to taking care of needed HOA business, is a great opportunity to get to know your neighbors. Everybody is welcome to attend and participate in discussions (renters included), but voting is limited to owners who's dues are paid. You can pay your dues at the meeting.

If you cannot attend, please consider giving your proxy vote to a neighbor or tenant to represent you. Proxies must bring a signed note from the owner they are representing.

The Annual Meeting is preceded by a community BBQ featuring hamburgers, cheese-burgers, hot dogs, salads, chips, drinks, cookies and, we hope, live music.

Covenant Changes?

The Board has been working to bring our 40+ year old covenants up to date. Thank you to those who made suggestions. Here are a few changes that we will be seeking approval to make in the coming months:

- Change the number of allowable pets from 2 to 4
- Allowing a few laying hens (no roosters) within guidelines
- Adding some flexibility to signage rules
- Restricting future mobile homes to lots that already have one

Our current covenants require any changes to be approved by 65% of our membership. This will be a difficult standard to meet but we will try to gather enough votes through mailed ballots, in-person voting at the annual meeting and a door to door drive if necessary. Failure to obtain the necessary votes on all or any changes will mean we continue on with the covenants already in place.

Who Do I Contact If...?

The GCC Board is often contacted to respond to a variety of issues. Reaching out to our volunteer board members can cause delays in the resolution of important issues. Here are examples and suggestions for where to start.

- I see suspicious or illegal activity: Please call the police (9-1-1) immediately to report.
- My neighbor's actions are creating a health hazard: Contact the Kitsap Public Health District at (360) 337-5235 or their website.
- Something needs repair at one of the parks:
 Contact the Board (see options in footer)
- I have questions about my GCC Dues: Contact the Board (see options in footer)
- A Realtor needs HOA information: Check the GCC website first. For property-specific info have the realtor call or e-mail the Board.
- My neighbor is violating one of GCC Covenants: Our covenants give each member legal standing to sue or claim damages in court. If your property value or enjoyment of property is being damaged by an infraction of our community rules and polite discussion with your neighbor does not resolve the issue, legal action may be required.
