- Speed issues on Gamble Bay road addressed with County by member and Board action (nod to Hank Fountain for spearheading that effort)
- Bids for play areas ground work solicited and received, moving forward
- Over 600 pounds of dog poop collected and kept out of Puget Sound
- Facebook group has grown to 90 members, great community communication going on

Goals for the coming year were discussed and priorities set by a consensus of members present. Projects we plan to address this year are:

- Replace corroding steel picnic table supports with concrete at waterfront park shelters
- A newly formed committee will work on ideas for replacing Gamblewood highway signage (thank you Hank Fountain and Mary Trimble).
- Create a 5 year budget plan
- Study options for gate replacement at waterfront park for member only access
- Launch improved Gamblewood website with ability to pay dues online

The last business of the meeting involved 2 Board positions whose terms were ending, they were both renominated and re-elected, leaving the Board's 5 members unchanged. At the BBQ we enjoyed live music by Bob Green and his friends and good food prepared by Donna and Phil Elena — thank you to them and all the members who gave a Saturday afternoon in June to help us with identifying priorities and participate in the governance of our community.
